OVERCOMING THE FEAR FACTOR

1. Fear is not promised.
 2. God is with us.
 3. God has destroyed Satan's works.
 4. We are led by the Spirit.
 5. We are filled with the perfect love of God.
 6. The law of God has made us free.
- We have been given the weapons to cast out fear.

1. Fear is not promised
 - A. Since fear is not promised, therefore we should not fear.
 1. II Timothy 1:7 For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and a sound mind
2. God is with us.
 - A. If God is with us, and He is, we should not fear. Who can stand against us?
 1. Acts 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.
 2. Hebrews 13:5-6 Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." So we may boldly say: "The Lord is my helper; I will not fear. What can man do to me?"
3. God has destroyed the works of satan.
 - A. If God has destroyed satan's works, we should not fear.
 1. I John 3:8 He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.
4. We are led by the Spirit.
 - A. If we are led by the Spirit, and we are, then we have no reason to fear.

1. Romans 8:14-15 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are the sons of God. For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, Abba, Father.
 5. We are filled with the perfect love of God.
 - A. If we are filled with the perfect love of God, and we are, then we should not fear.
 1. I John 4:16-18 And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him. Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world. There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment, but he who fears has not been made perfect in love.
 6. The law of God makes us free.
 - A. According to the law of God, we are free from fear.
 1. Romans 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.
 7. We have the weapons to cast out fear.
 - A. Fear should have no place in our lives, because we have been given the weapons to cast it out.
 1. II Corinthians 10:3-5 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds. Casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ.
- How do we keep fear at bay?
1. Say what the word says, keep it coming out of your mouth.
